Guest Speaker Monday, October 15, 2018: Dr. Messika-Zeitoun a cardiologist in the Division of Cardiology at the University of Ottawa Heart Institute (UOHI) and a full professor in the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Ottawa. His presentation to our group will be on, "A new research team dealing with current management and new opportunities for the treatment of Mitral Regurgitation.

Our last meeting guest speaker Dr Luc Beauchene was extremely informative about adult congenital cardiac patients. The congenital patients start at birth and are looked after at the CHEO until they are 17 years old then are transferred to the UOHI. The presentation covered many situations and defects occurring that require congenital patients be followed through their lives.
