Wednesday, September 4, 2019: the OHSG Executive Committee meeting will be held at the Holland's house, 6029 Voyageur Drive in Orleans starting at 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Monday, September 16, 2019, Guest Speaker is: Andrew Crean, MD, Professor of Medicine (Cardiology) and Radiology University of Ottawa Heart Institute. Topic: Takotsubo Cardiomyopathy: Not Rare, Not Benign, Not Recognized.

Dr. Andrew Crean is appointed as a Professor of Medicine within the Division of Cardiology and acts as the co-director of the cardiac MRI service at the University of Ottawa Heart Institute. He is a Clinician-Investigator with a focus in uncommon cardiac conditions.

Dr Andrew Crean's presentation is very important for the patient stress content but also the imaging you may see during the presentation that may relate for congenital patients.
