#### **Activities**

Wednesday, March 1, 2017: the OHSG Executive Committee meeting will be held at the Holland's house 6029 Voyageur Drive, Orleans ON K1C 2P5. From 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Monday, March 20, 2017: The Guest Speaker is Juan B. Grau, MD, a cardiac surgeon at the University of Ottawa Heart Institute. The Topic is: "Translational Cardiovascular Research: From Changing Patient Treatment in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century." A native of Spain, Dr Grau finished his medical degree and research fellowship in Madrid in 1990 and 1992, respectively. Moving to New York, Dr Grau completed his General Surgery Internship and Residency at NYU Medical Center, where he also served as Executive Chief Resident in General Surgery; he then completed a three-year Research Fellowship at the NYU Laboratory of Developmental Biology and Repair.

In 2000, Dr Grau became the surgeon in charge at the Trauma and Shock Unit at the Bellevue Hospital, the largest level 1 trauma centre in New York City. He then completed his cardiothoracic surgery fellowship at NYU Medical Center, Department of Cardiothoracic Surgery. He spent five years as Faculty Attending Surgeon at NYU School of Medicine and NYU Medical Center and in 2008 moved to Philadelphia to join the faculty at The University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine, followed by Columbia University in 2011.
