Topic: "Heart disease in men and how to cope with the trauma that follows a cardiac event." Heather Tulloch is a Clinical, Health, and Rehabilitation Psychologist at the University of Ottawa Heart Institute and Assistant Professor with the Department of Medicine, in the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Ottawa. Heather received her bachelor's degree in psychology in 1995 from the University of Manitoba in Winnipeg, which she followed with an MSc in Clinical Psychology from North Dakota State University in Fargo in 2000, and a PhD in Clinical Psychology from the University of Ottawa in 2007.
